Free and Confidential Assistance

Through the federal Rehabilitation Act, people with disabilities have a right to services provided by Vocational Rehabilitation (VR), Centers for Independent Living, and other services. The Client Assistant Program (CAP) is a program of the Disability Rights Center of Kansas that assists people seeking those services. We help people with disabilities make informed choices throughout the Vocational Rehabilitation and Independent Living process. We help Kansans with disabilities understand and exercise their right to these services.

Who does the CAP serve?

The CAP can help you if you are a client or applicant of Kansas Rehabilitation Services (Vocational Rehabilitation – VR – in Kansas), Centers for Independent Living, Projects with Industries, or any other program funded under the Rehabilitation Act. You must also want to work, have a disability that makes it hard for you to work, and need supports or services to help you have a job.

Have Questions or Need Information

We can answer questions about navigating the services funded by the Rehabilitation Act. We can help you better understand your right to services.



Need Help Resolving an Issue

We can help you resolve disagreements or problems, like delays in the application process, communication issues, not getting the services you need (including through VR), unmet technical assistance needs, etc.



Need Help in the Appeals Process

If you have been denied eligibility and disagree with the reason for denial, we may be able to help. We may also provide representation to you if you aren't getting the services you need. This can be through advocacy, appeals, administrative reviews, mediation, or hearings.
